# What is Summer Discovery?

Summer Discovery is an outdoor education program with four main goals: 1) increase enthusiasm for learning and discovery; 2) develop community awareness; 3) build a greater appreciation of our wondrous natural world; and 4) foster a sense of individual responsibility for the care and wise use of our natural resources.

#### What will do we do?

We will take walks in the woods, catch creek critters, play games, talk to the birds, visit Fern Hollow Lake on Friday, and much more!

#### Who can sign up?

Any student who is *presently* in 3rd, 4th, 5th, or 6th grade (2022-23) is eligible. Spaces are limited but we accept applications until we are full at 24 students per week.

#### When and Where does it happen?

Week 2: June 26 - 30 at Shelter 4

Week 1: June 19 - 23 at Shelter 2 OR Monday through Thursday: We will meet in Walker Park. Look for our sign along Little Sewickley Creek Road. Friday: We will meet at Fern Hollow Lake (124 Fern Hollow Road) which is on the left on the way to Bell Acres Recreation Park from Walker Park. Look for our sign.

Time: 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM

#### How much?

The tuition is \$40 for one camper, \$60 for two campers or \$75 for three campers in the same family. (If cost is an issue, scholarships are available). Please make checks out to Little Sewickley Creek Watershed Association and submit with registration form.

## What should I wear?

Dress for the weather as Summer Discovery will happen rain or shine. Shorts and T-shirts are fine as long as it is warm enough.
