Notes

1. This project is both sponsored and undertaken by the Little Sewickley Creek Watershed Association, P.O. Box 183, Leetsdale, Pennsylvania 15056.
2. Plant families are listed in phylogenetic order according to the system used by the herbarium of the Carnegie Museum of Natural History, Pittsburgh (modified from the system of Engler and Prantl). Genera and species are alphabetized within their families.
3. For more information on each specimen (location, habitat, etc.) reference may be made to the collection journal which is maintained by the Little Sewickley Watershed Association.
4. One set of these plant specimens is located in the LSCWA herbarium case in Sewickley. The second set is located in the herbarium of the Carnegie Museum of Natural History in Pittsburgh.
5. This collection at present represents about one-third of the plant species thought to occur in the Little Sewickley Creek Watershed.

### Little Sewickley Creek Watershed

Little Sewickley Creek is a small southwest-flowing stream in the central portion of the dissected Appalachian Plateau and is located in Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, approximately 21.7 km northwest of Pittsburgh. The stream drains an area of 25.2 square km and empties into the Ohio River which flows northwest in this area...Portions of the watershed lie in the boroughs of Franklin Park, Sewickley Hills, Bell Acres, Sewickley Heights, Edgeworth, Leetsdale, and Leet Township. The majority of the watershed is presently in a rural state (94% forest or grassland) while the surrounding areas are basically suburban residential, urban, and industrial...The rocks at the surface in the watershed are Middle Pennsylvanian in age (approximately 300 million years old) and are part of the Conemaugh Group. This group is further broken down into two formations (the older Glenshaw and the Casselman) which are separated by the thin Ames Limestone bed. In general, the beds are flat-lying sandstones, shales and siltstones. Glacial-fluvial deposits (a result of continental glaciation in the Pleistocene Epoch) along with the easily eroded "red beds" (red siltstones, shales and claystones) have resulted in an abnormally wide floodplain below 1000 feet in the Little Sewickley Creek Watershed. The dominant soils are moderately deep, well-drained soils formed from relatively acid shale and sandstone.

The climate of the Pittsburgh region is classified as temperate continental with warm summers and the average annual precipitation of 100 cm.

The watershed topography consists of steep hillsides with flat uplands at 1100 feet corresponding to the surface of the Appalachian Plateau.
